Remark:

According to Children's Products Containing Lead; Exemptions for Certain Electronic Devices; Interim Final Rule, exemptions were granted to steel alloy containing up to 0.35 % lead by weight/ aluminium containing up to 0.4 % lead by weight/ copper-based alloy containing up to 4 % lead by weight. Therefore, this material containing the found heavy metals level should be exempted.

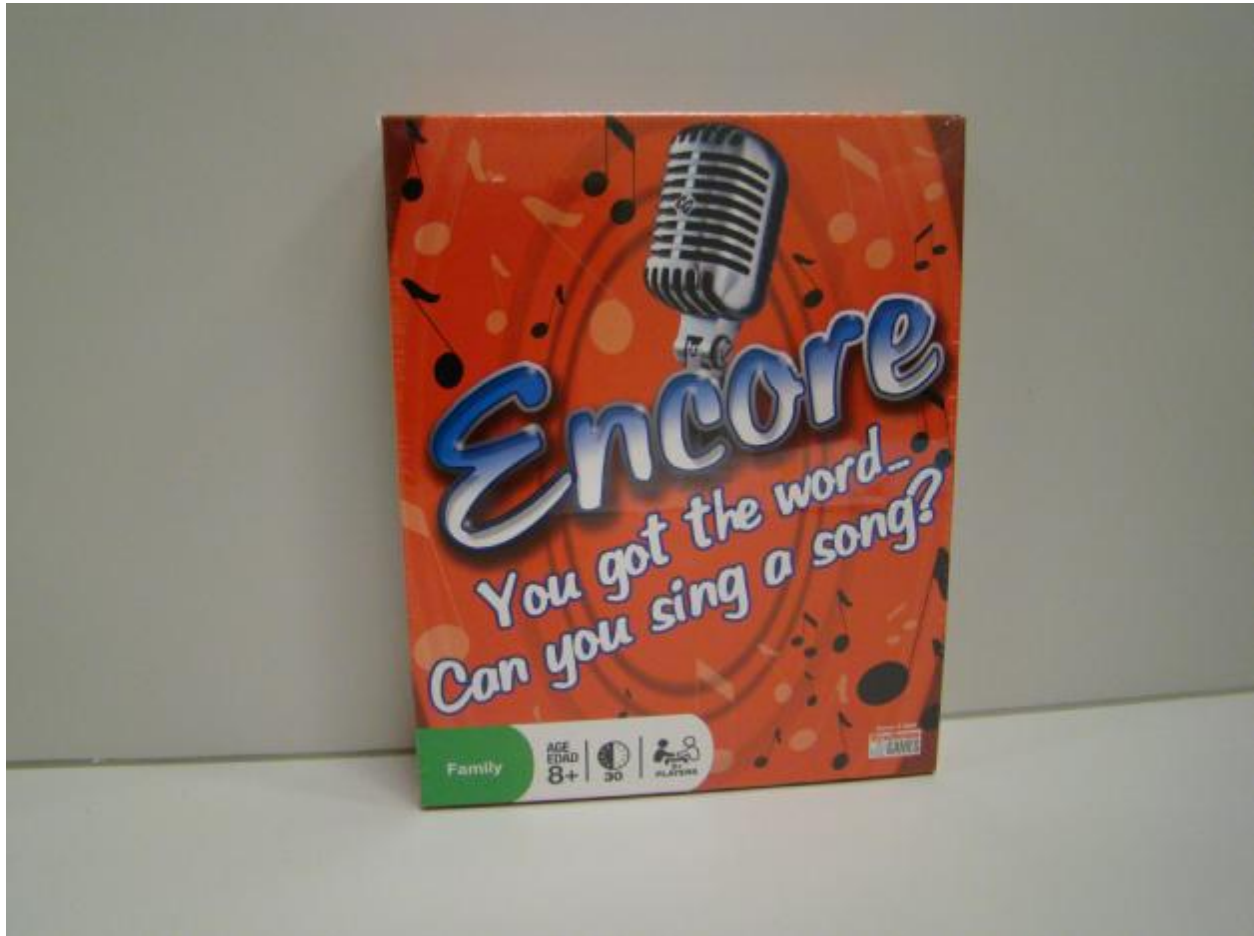

 - 2) According to CPSIA, DINP, DIDP and DNOP shall not be used as substances or as constituents of preparations, at concentrations of greater than 0.1 % by mass of the plasticized material, in toys of children ages 12 and under which can be placed in the mouth, and childcare articles of children 3 and under which can be placed in the mouth.
