## Beginner Play

### COLLECTING CORN

#### OBJECT:

Be the first player to collect 7 Corn cards.

#### HOW TO PLAY

- Place the spinner on the playing surface.
- Shuffle the deck of playing cards, place the deck face down and turn the top card over to begin a discard pile.
- Youngest player goes first. Play continues to the left. (clockwise).
- SPINNER: On your turn, always spin the spinner first. If you land on a Pig Eating Corn, shout, "Oink!" and draw the number of cards allowed (1 or 2). If you land on a Pig in the Mud, you lose your turn.
- CARDS: If you draw a Corn card, place it face up in front of you. If you draw a Wild Pig card, return 1 of your Corn cards to the discard pile. If you draw 1 of the Pig on the Farm cards, discard it to the discard pile.

•If the draw pile runs out before a player has won the game, reshuffle the deck and continue play.

•WINNING THE GAME: The first player to collect 7 Corn cards shouts, "Pig Out!" and wins the game.

## Advanced Play

### COLLECTING CORN AND PIGS

#### OBJECT:

Be the first to collect 1 of each of the Pig on the Farm cards: Pig Laying in the Sun, Pig Laying on the Haystack, Pig Laying under the Tree, Pig Swimming in the Pond and 4 Corn cards so each pig has an ear of corn to eat.

#### HOW TO PLAY

- Place the spinner on the playing surface.
- Shuffle the deck of playing cards, place the deck face down and turn the top card over to begin a discard pile.
- Youngest player goes first. Play continues to the left.
- SPINNER: On your turn, always spin the spinner first.
