Like the popular TV Game Show, The Newlywed Game™ Deluxe Edition tests your knowledge of how much you and your significant other know... or don't know about each other. The object of the game is to score points by matching answers to couple related questions. The couple with the most points after two rounds of questions wins!

Note: You will need tissues to wipe marker off scorecard and answer cards.

Rules for Standard Game

The Newlywed Game is played in couples. For each game, one player is elected to read the questions to be answered. The questions are read and answered in order. 2, 3, or 4 couples may play.

Each round consists of 10 questions - five for the wives and five for the husbands - plus one bonus question. For each answer matched correctly, the couple is awarded 20-50 points, based on the value of the question. (I.e., questions No. 1, 2, 3 are worth 20 points.) Couples receive points for each correct matching answer.

Highest score after 3 rounds wins.

Playing the Game

Couples sit facing each other a few feet apart. The men on one side, and the women on the other. The questions are asked to the women first; starting with "Round 1 Women."

The first question is read and each wife writes down her answer. Question is re-read and the first husband announces his answer. If it is the same as his wife has written, he wins points.

The husband of the second couple announces his answer. Couple 3 and 4 follow in order.

Circle score on scorecard for correct answer, then erase board and go to question 2. The second question is read, and the game continues as above.

After the 5th question, the game continues with the husbands, and each writes his answers to questions No.1-5 "Round 1 Men." Wives then announce their answers in order. The correct match for questions No.1, 2 and 3 are worth 20 points. Correct matches for questions No.4 and 5 are worth 50 points.

Following "Round 1 Women" and "Round 1 Men," the men are asked to write the answer to bonus question 1, on answer card. Wives must match answers to win 100 points. Following "Round 2 Women" and "Round 2 Men," the women are asked to write the answer to bonus question 2, on answer card. Husbands must match answers to win 100 points, and so on. Bonus questions are found in the back of this book.

Set Up:

The Newlywed Game™ can be played by 1 or more couples.

Pass out 1 marker and wipe-off answer board to each couple. Make yourselves comfortable and load the DVD.

Setting Up the DVD:

Insert the Game DVD into the player. After a short introduction, the Main Menu will appear.

Choose one player to operate the remote while navigating the Main Menu.

To start, choose the NUMBER OF COUPLES you'll be playing with at home. You'll have the option of playing with a couple from the original TV series - if you choose this option you'll then need to SELECT YOUR TV COUPLE.

NOTE: Since you'll be asked the same questions that were given to the couple on the original TV show, make sure you play a different couple than you've played before to avoid getting the same questions.

Then you'll need to decide what the SPECIALLY SELECTED PRIZE for your winning couple will be. On the original show this was often a new sofa, a dinette set, or a refrigerator. (Remember, this is just a game - don't make your friends give you their new furniture!) Decide on a drink, a favor, or you can "own" their dinette set just for fun.

Finally, you will be prompted to predict what your final score will be. Each couple must record on their dry-erase board what they think their final score will be. This prediction is your one and only tie-breaker in The Newlywed Game™, so give this some thought!

Once you set your game, you'll be introduced to your couple - then GAME PLAY will begin.

How to Play:

The game consists of 2 rounds of 3 questions each:

In the first round, the guys answer first and each question is worth 5 points.

In Round 2, the ladies write their answers and questions are now worth 10 points.

A perfect score at the end of 2 rounds of play would be 45 points.

Once the first question is asked to begin Round 1, all husbands may begin writing down what they think their wives will say to the same question. If applicable, the TV husband will reveal his answer. Once all gentlemen are ready - beginning with the couple who has been together the longest - the wives reveal their answers aloud. Should HER answer match what HE wrote down, it's a match and the couple scores 5 points! When playing a TV couple they will also reveal their answers at this point. Please allow for a natural "match or no-match" reaction to occur, such as a peck on the cheek, or a pillow to the face before continuing play!

Score is kept on screen for your convenience.

Questions 2 and 3 will take place in the same manner.

After 3 questions, the game shifts to Round 2 where the women write their answers and the men speak theirs aloud. The play remains the same but question point values are now double.

After all six questions have been asked, the couple with the most points wins a Specially Selected Prize that has been chosen JUST FOR THEM!

In the case of a tie, the couple that predicted closest to their actual final score wins the prize.
